- Special events may reserve all RV Sites which could require RV guests to move to another site or to another offsite RV park. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.
- Payment is due at check in. Make checks payable to Southwestern Fair Commission, Inc or SWFC. All major credit cards are accepted.
- Vehicles parked or block other sites, or are in no parking areas are subject to tow
- All RV's are required to have an "O" ring for sewer connections. Water hoses must be in good condition and without leaks.
 - Sewer hoses must be connected to a donut or a sewer hose connector.
 - Do not place your sewer hose directly into our sewers. This causes a back up of our sewer system and emits toxic gases. Sewer hoses are available to purchase at the RV Office.
- Electric cords must be in safe operating condition and adaptable to SWFC outlets. Hard wiring is prohibited
- The Southwestern Fair Commission, Inc. is not liable for the fluctuations in electricity or damage caused to or within the RV, trailer, tent, etc. due to power surges.
- Drones are prohibited under Pima County Rule 1.120. If interested in flying a drone you must contact Southern Arizona Modelers Club at 240-8243 and be a member of AMA (Academy of Model Aeronautics).
- Quiet Time is from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am. The use of generators during these hours is prohibited.
- The RV Park at the Pima County Fairgrounds is part of a multi-use facility. Some dates coincide with a concert or other events with amplified music that could go past the quiet time hours.
- No Firearms, Fireworks, Open Fires such as Wood or Charcoal fires.
- Self-contained gas fire pits may be allowed but must be pre-approved by the RV Host. Please see your camp host for more information prior to setting up.
- No storage units. All excess equipment/supplies must be stored within the RV unit
- Due to the location of our property Wi-Fi is **NOT** guaranteed. Interference can be caused by weather, location and events.
- Dry camping in tents or vehicles not permitted unless approved by the SWFC Management Team.
- The speed limit is 5mph. All applicable driving laws apply and include the use of golf carts. Golf carts are only to be operated by a person 16-years of age or older. All vehicles, including golf carts must remain on designated driving areas. Children should be supervised at all times.
- Please keep some water in your holding tank. Temporary power outages could temporarily interrupt the well water system. Please do not drive on the grass
- Clean up after your pet. Pets are to be kept on a leash and walked outside the perimeter of each site. Pets are not to be tied up at any time. Portable dog pens only, no dog pens may be constructed to the facility attached to trees, fences or grounds. Guests with aggressive or barking pets may be asked to leave the park without refund. Pens cannot exceed 5ft by 5ft and all dog pens must be pre-approved by the camp host.
- Disposal of all trash is the guest's responsibility including, beer cap's, bottles, cans, cigarette butts. We believe we have a beautiful clean and tidy desert setting which we wish to maintain for all our guests.
- Only one RV and one vehicle per site. Guests taking up more than one space will be charged for the additional space used. Overflow parking is available in designated areas. Please see your camp host and discuss upon check in.
- RV guests should be aware of our desert visitors for this reason you may find Coyotes, Rattlesnakes, Bobcats, Bears, Javelinas, Gila Monsters, Spiders, Centipedes, Bees, Wasps, Scorpions, etc. If you come across any of these please don't disturb them.

Backflow Prevention-Federal and State law require that water suppliers protect their water systems from contamination. Residences used for other purposes, as well as commercial and industrial customers are required by the Arizona Administrative Code rule R18-4-215 to install and maintain backflow prevention assemblies. Charges will be applied if the YELLOW backflow preventers that re located on the RV Site are removed.
